



Post 16 Dress Code

In the sixth form you will be expected to dress sensibly and in a respectful manner, maintaining a smart and appropriate appearance that would be acceptable to staff and pupils.

Accepted Dress:

- Trousers or skirt of an appropriate length.
- Tailored shorts of an appropriate length
- Shirt, polo shirt or blouse
- Dresses of an appropriate length and style.
- Sweater, jumper or cardigan
- Suit/or jacket and tie (optional)
- Appropriate shoes.

Unaccepted Dress:

- Ripped jeans
- Sportswear, including tops/Sweatshirts/Jogging Bottoms/Tracksuits (unless required for a Sport or Dance lesson).
- Caps or hats inside the school building.
- No 'strappy' or cropped tops
- Beachwear
- Any items of clothing featuring inappropriate logos or slogans.

If your standard of dress is deemed to be outside of our expectations your tutor will speak to you about this, repeated breaches of the dress code will result in a formal meeting.

All students should clearly have their lanyards visible at all times whilst on site.
