



Visit to the Leicester- UK University and Apprenticeship Fair
Tuesday 11th March 2025

Dear Parents / Carers,

As part of your son/daughter's Post 16 education it is important that they are provided with information, advice and guidance in relation to their Post 18 options. For most of our students, this is likely to be a choice between further study, an apprenticeship or full-time employment, and throughout the course of the next 18 months, we aim to provide information and support to help students in making important decisions about their futures.

As part of this process, there will be a visit to the UK University and Apprenticeship Fair on Tuesday 11th March, which is being held at the King Power Stadium, Leicester. The visit aims to provide students with information and guidance for their future progression beyond Quarrydale, giving students the opportunity to gather information about specific universities and the courses they offer, as well as meeting with apprenticeship and employment providers who can provide details on the types of apprenticeships they offer, typical vacancies and how to apply.

The visit is free of charge with transport by coach provided. We will be leaving school at 9am and expect to be back in school for approximately 1:30pm. Students will need to bring a packed lunch, or they can purchase food from one of the food outlets at the stadium.

All students will be required to register for their own ticket prior to the event and will be sent the required link, along with detailed information on how to register, to their school email addresses. Students will need to log on and access this as soon as possible. Once they have registered, each student will receive their own confirmation email, with a link to their ticket /QR code, which they will be able to print whilst at school or use electronically.

We understand that some of our students may have already made a decision about their chosen progression route, but it is imperative that all students have knowledge and information that can support all possible progression routes and options, and as such, we strongly encourage all students to attend the event.

If you agree to your son/daughter attending the event please provide consent via the MyChildatSchool app/website by Friday 7th March.
