Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 8 Drayton Manor Rewards Trip – Tuesday 1st July 2025

We are pleased to offer Year 8 students the opportunity to attend a rewards trip to Drayton Manor. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. However, students **must meet the following criteria** in order to attend:

- No more than 25 demerits
- No suspensions

Demerits will be monitored from **Monday 12th May 2025** until **Thursday 26th June 2025**. Students who do not meet the criteria will not be permitted to attend the trip.

The cost of the trip is **£35.00**. The deposit is **£15.00** which needs to be paid via MyChildatSchool no later than **Friday 23rd May 2025**. Please note that the deposit is non-refundable if you later decide your child will not attend. The remaining balance of **£20.00** needs to be paid by **Sunday 8th June 2025**

Your child will require some spending money for lunch/other activities whilst at Drayton Manor, however we recommend **no more than £20.00**. Pupils are responsible for any valuables they bring, including money and mobile phones. Please note that unless your child is Free School Meals, **lunch is not included**.

Students are not required to wear school uniform, but clothing must be appropriate—**no crop tops or short skirts** are allowed. Please dress according to the weather; sun cream or a raincoat may be necessary (check the weather forecast on the day).

The trip will depart from school at **8:30 AM**. Please ensure your child arrives on time—we will register in the hall before departure. We expect to return between **5:30 PM and 6:00 PM**, so please make arrangements for your child to get home at that time.



During the visit, staff will be contactable at all times but students will be allowed to explore the parks in small groups.

If your child has any medical conditions, please provide the necessary medication (e.g., inhalers, travel sickness tablets). These will be kept safe with the designated First Aid staff during the trip.

As always, we expect our students to represent the academy in a respectful and responsible manner.

Excellent behaviour is essential and will be expected throughout the trip.
