Year 11 Alton Towers Rewards Trip – Friday 27th March 2026

The cost of the trip per pupil is £10.00 which needs to be paid via the MyChildatSchool no later than Wednesday 11th March 2026.

Your child will require some spending money for lunch/other activities whilst at Alton Towers. Pupils are responsible for any valuables they bring, including money and mobile phones. Please note that unless your child is Free School Meals, **lunch is not included**.

Students are not required to wear school uniform, but clothing must be appropriate—**no crop tops or short skirts** are allowed. Please dress according to the weather; sun cream or a raincoat may be necessary (check the weather forecast on the day).
