Year 9 Alton Towers Rewards Trip – Friday 27th March 2026

We are pleased to offer Year 9 students the opportunity to attend a rewards trip to Alton Towers on Friday 27th March 2026, however, students **must meet the following criteria** in order to attend:

These are:

- No suspensions
- No significant behaviour events

Behaviour will be monitored from Monday 19th January until **Friday 6th March 2026**. Students who do not meet the criteria will not be permitted to attend the trip.

The cost of the trip per pupil is **£23.00**. **A deposit of £10.00 must be paid via MyChildatSchool no later than Saturday 31st January 2026.**

The remaining balance of **£13.00 is due by 11th March 2026**. We will only contact you if your child has **not** met the required criteria; therefore, if you have not been contacted by **6th March 2026**, please proceed to pay the full remaining balance by the deadline.

If your child holds a Merlin Pass, please make us aware as the cost will only be £10.00 to cover the cost of travel.

Your child will require some spending money for lunch/other activities whilst at Alton Towers. Pupils are responsible for any valuables they bring, including money and mobile phones. Please note that unless your child is Free School Meals, **lunch is not included**.
